COUNCIL OAK rated back and inside, moved up into the second turn, raced boxed and steadied through the turn, then was blocked into and through the stretch steadying along, angled in and closed fast when clear to get up in the final strides. SURPLUS stalked the early pace inside, challenged for and gained a short lead into the stretch, then gained a clear lead inside the furlong marker and was outfinished. LITTLE WAGON void of speed, circled the field through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, closed and hung. FIRST CAPTAIN well placed and between rivals, angled in quickly, raced boxed through the second turn, then angled out to bid three wide and lacked the needed late kick. DON'T BLUFF well back, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and flattened out. COCONINO SLIM mid pack and inside, was boxed through the second turn, dropped back slightly waiting, then found room inside and raced evenly the final furlong. PAGE MEADOWS set the pace off the rail and faltered the final furlong. KING OF THE SKY well placed and three wide, was through after a half.
