### Footnotes

DALBO set all the pace along the inside and held gamely in the drive to be clear under strong pressure. L G SUPREM was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide in the stretch and closed in on the latter stages. CYCLONE CANYON was off a step slow, saved ground and made a mild late gain. SONNY MONEY pressed the pace, jumped tracks at the five eighths pole and weakened late. COULD B THE DAY was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. HALL OF JUSTICE failed to respond. MILK MONEY showed little. GHAZI'S PATCH WORK failed to sustain a bid.
