**Footnotes**

EXOTIC EXOTIC, taken in hand soon after the break, tracked just off the first flight saving ground to the backstretch, continued unhurried from that position through the far turn, was guided outside the leaders nearing the lane, rallied to the front and held SNUGGLIN' MAN safe under pressure. The latter was reserved well off the pace in early stages, slowly drew into contention on the outside leaving the far turn, fanned five wide in upper stretch and continued well in a belated effort. BALKO BAY stalked just and outside the leaders racing into the first turn, advanced on those foes to challenge three deep entering the far turn, briefly gained a narrow advantage in upper stretch but couldn't fend off the top pair. PEAK INTEREST worked his way to the inside in the opening quarter under rating, stalked the pace through the far turn, split foes entering the lane and made a mild gain late. ALYMIR tracked the pace in second flight while four wide to the backstretch, advanced from that position to challenge on the second bend but couldn't sustain that effort through the last quarter. IT'S TRULY OBVIOUS went up from the break, forced the pace outside DONTHELUMBERTRADER, dueled with that foe to upper stretch and weakened in the drive. PREMIERE DANCER was never a factor. DONTHELUMBERTRADER was hustled to the front, disputed the tempo on the rail for six furlongs and gave way in the lane. YOUR DRAW, reserved in the opening stages while angling in a bit, never gained striking position. STICKLER was caught five wide chasing the leaders into the first turn and emptied out early.
