POWDER RIVER broke sharply, took up a stalking position racing just off the leaders three deep to the backstretch, advanced readily to wrest command on the far turn, turned back a challenge entering upper stretch and made the balance of the pace under firm encouragement. IRISH ACCENT, allowed to settle just off the inside in the opening stages, made smart progress to gain striking distance entering the far turn, came through on the rail nearing upper stretch to challenge the winner but proved second best. BAD BAD GIRL joined the pace along the rail, dueled for command into the far turn, then weakened in the drive. SEENEMONNA T. V. led the second flight to the backstretch off the inside, bid between foes nearing upper stretch but had no final kick. NO. ONE SUSPECT tracked the leaders racing three wide in second flight for a half, swung four wide entering the lane and continued evenly to late stages. SHESALITTLEDANDY was allowed to settle and offered no rally. EMERALD TORI was hustled between foes to join the pace, dueled for command for a half, gave way abruptly, was soon outdistanced and walked off the course under her own power.
