Footnotes

STIG'S DEPUTY well placed and inside, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. WESTERN TWIST stalked the early pace outside, challenged for and gained a short lead through the turn, then could not match the winners stride late while clearly best of the rest. WHISKEY DOUBLE well placed and inside, moved up and angled out to bid four wide into the stretch and flattened out. NO PEACE AT ALL stalked the early pace inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and weakened the final furlong. STRONG DREAM well back and inside, moved up through the turn and improved his position. GHOST FIVE well back and outside, moved up through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch and had no rally. RUSTIC ROAD set the early pace from between rivals and stopped.
