FRANKIE DAPPER mid pack and outside, moved up three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drew off late. REDNECK RICHIE vied for the early lead outside, gained the lead when a rival broke down, then could not match strides with the winner late while clearly best of the rest. KING AJAX well placed and outside, fanned widest into the stretch and lost ground while gaining the place spot. BRASS BOLT void of speed, improved his position. JULIAN LOVE moved up on the inside and had no stretch rally. LIZ'S PIRATE showed little. BRAVE LITTLE BULL was no factor. EBBTIDE set the pace on the inside, shook clear into the stretch and broke down.
