B'WANAGOLDMINE well back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid four wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. FIRST CAPTAIN stalked the early pace inside, angled out to bid just outside the pace setter into the stretch, closed willingly through the lane and was outfinished. HIGH SPIRIT void of speed and on the rail, closed fast to get up for the show while no threat to the top two. MISTER MERZ well placed and off the rail, moved to a striking position on the two path through the second turn, then weakened the final furlong. I AM AWESOME gained position through the second turn and had no rally. DALLIANCE mid pack and inside, raced boxed and steadied through the second turn, split rivals through the lane and came up empty. MACK'S MONARCH set the pace outside, gained a clear lead quickly and stopped after three quarters.
