Footnotes

NATURE COAST, unhurried outside foes in the opening stages, angled inwards while making steady progress entering the turn, split foes in upper stretch to challenge, then just prevailed over ANGELANO under brisk handling. The latter was rated in hand tracking the pacesetter, came out a bit on the turn to bid four deep for command, held a narrow advantage in upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge to the end while drifting out late but came up second best. LASTING AFFAIR stalked the pacesetter racing into the turn, closed the gap on that foe ranging just outside that rival racing into the lane but couldn't sustain the effort through the final three sixteenths. ASTUTA was under pressure early, chased the leaders from the outside into the lane but offered no closing bid. JOCY'S COYOTE was a bit slow into stride, came out leaving the bend and passed tiring rivals. R. G. GEORGEANNE tracked the first flight along the inside, bid for command along the rail leaving the quarter pole but flattened out markedly in the final furlong. SHES IN FRONT broke slowly and never gained striking distance. STICKY GUM was bumped at the start by HEAVENESCENT and never menaced thereafter. LIL KITTEN made the pace just off the inside to the lane, then emptied out in upper stretch. HEAVENESCENT broke out, bumped a foe and dropped out entering the turn.
