Footnotes

HANA BAND, never far back, stalked just off the leaders racing three wide to the backstretch, made a steady advance in that path to challenge on the far turn, took over in upper stretch and made the balance of the pace under firm encouragement. POWERFUL PEPPER, allowed to settle along the inside in the opening half, came around foes racing into upper stretch to prove best of the others. PERHAM angled inwards to track just off the first flight racing to the far turn, then continued evenly through the stretch for a share. MARIA'S SIREN stalked just off the pacesetter in the opening half, bid between foes racing through the far turn and gave way. MATT N MITCH was allowed to settle in the opening stages but never gained striking position. ZOIE'S RUN sped to the lead from the break, dueled for command along the inside for six furlongs and gave way leaving the far turn. JUST JOSH'N tracked the pace unhurried off the inside to the backstretch but never mounted a serious challenge. DIRT FARMER never seriously menaced. R BOY NAMED SIOUX dropped out early.
