Footnotes

COLONEL JOE raced unhurried saving ground while just out of striking distance in the opening stages, came through to advance when presented an opening midway through the backstretch, shifted outside the leaders to gain terms with those foes three deep entering the far turn, attended the pace to upper stretch, then readily took over and drew clear under steady prompting. HARDTAX raced unhurried along the inside in the opening half, split foes entering upper stretch and continued well enough to secure the place late. CORKSAPOPIN stalked just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, dropped off the pace entering the far turn, but continued willingly inside HARDTAX in the final stages to gain a share. SPICED UP GHAZI was allowed to settle along the inside in the opening, made some progress leaving the far turn, then swung out racing into the stretch continuing with a belated effort. TUGFIRE tracked the leaders between foes in second flight to the far turn, angled out in upper stretch to briefly challenge, drifted out sharply near the three sixteenths marker and quickly gave way. BORN RUNNING sped to the lead along the inside, dictated the pace into the far turn, was no match for the winner and gave way. SUPREME WARRIOR tracked the leaders outside foes in second flight, was carried out by TUGFIRE in upper stretch and quickly gave way. GLADDENS CHOICE broke awkwardly, lost position and never gained contention. SILENT PREACHER never seriously menaced. POWER PAWS, reserved a bit in early stages, never mounted a serious challenge. BEAVER LAKES BEST was caught four wide racing to the backstretch and dropped out early.
