TAPINOT set the pace on the inside, drew off in the lane while drifting out badly. ITOUCH GOLD tracked the pace on the inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, got up for the place while loosing ground and was best of the rest. MAGICAL STORM vied for the early lead outside, then weakened in the drive and held the show. CRAFTY SCORE mid pack and inside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch and ran evenly. G FROST passed a tiring rival. KID CALLAGHAN well placed and off the rail, pulled to position, drifted out badly through the second turn and faded. LAUNCH N LUKE was never involved.
