Footnotes

BETTER MAKE MONEY, bumped and squeezed between rivals at the start, was allowed to collect himself racing outside foes, made steady progress four wide on the bend to gain striking distance, then continued in that path to wrest command late under firm left handed urging. HOPETOWN HERO prompted the pace three deep racing into the bend, edged clear leaving the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the winner. SENOR SMILEY went readily to the lead, dictated the pace between foes through the bend, but steadily weakened in the drive. CONKIGO broke in, bumped BETTER MAKE MONEY, was righted to track just off and outside the first flight, but lugged in racing through the stretch while fading from contention. ALEX'S TOMCAT broke out, bumped BETTER MAKE MONEY, was settled tracking the leaders but never gained contention. TIPPAMAN was a brief factor attending the pace but gave way after the opening quarter.
