### Footnotes

PINK MARTINI, reserved saving ground in the opening half, gradually gathered momentum midway through the far turn while being shifted off the inside, was fanned seven wide entering upper stretch, then produced a sustained response to wrest command leaving the sixteenth marker and pull clear under firm encouragement. ULTIMAT PERFECTION stalked just behind the leaders racing into the backstretch, briefly awaited an opening leaving the far turn, was steadied entering upper stretch, came through to challenge for command in the lane but proved only second best. CATHY'S CLOWN raced unhurried outside rivals in early stages, advanced readily entering the far turn to challenge four wide in upper stretch but was outfinished in the final stages. PRIMA DANCER, unhurried tracking the pace in the opening half, came out entering the lane and made some belated progress racing into the stretch. LOVELY KAEELYN, forwardly placed outside a rival in the opening half while attending the pace, pressed the pace on the far turn, gained brief command in midstretch but faltered in the final furlong. RADA BE A BADGER raced unhurried between foes in the opening half, angled out leaving the far turn but lacked the needed final response. LUCKY LIBBY was hustled to the front, dictated the pace along the inside racing to the far turn, then gave way in the drive. YOUR IMAGINATION tracked just off the leaders along the inside to the backstretch, then faded steadily from contention on the far turn. BABY EYES raced unhurried tracking the leaders in early stages but never mounted a serious challenge. TRUE HUNTER retreated from contention early.
