DINNER MAGIC stalked the pace along the rail racing to the bend, was shuffled a bit approaching the bend, angled out when presented an opening nearing upper stretch and made steady progress to wrest command and edged clear under firm prompting. DR. CHO forced the pace outside foes five deep in the opening furlong, shook clear nearing the turn, opened a commanding advantage on the bend but proved no match when confronted by the winner late. A SONG FOR YOU chased the pacesetter along the inside to upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with that rival but continued well enough to save a share. BERWYN, prominent between foes in the opening quarter, couldn't keep pace after three furlongs, raced four deep into upper stretch but made no impact. MYPALMBEACHANGEL flashed brief pace between foes but emptied out early. TOLSTOY TRICK never seriously menaced. COLD BROOK, off awkwardly, lost position to the field and never threatened thereafter. STORMY MARKET trailed.
