Footnotes

DIMPLE PINCH was settled along the inside in the opening stages, came out nearing upper stretch while readily drawing into striking position, split foes four wide in upper stretch to challenge for command and pulled clear late under firm handling. SALTY ATTRACTION was allowed to settle outside foes in early stages, advanced four deep on the bend, swung five wide entering upper stretch while gaining a brief advantage in upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner. SUTRA stalked just outside the leaders racing to the turn, went up to press the issue three deep to upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the top pair late. FAMOUS GAL stalked the pacesetter along the inside to the turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. RARE CRYSTAL sprinted clear along the inside from the break, set the pace to upper stretch and emptied out.
