FIRST CAPTAIN broke sharply, angled to the inside while dictating the tempo racing into the bend, then came under stout left handed pressure leaving the furlong marker to gamely hold the challenge of NOMOREWINEFOREDDIE to prevail. The latter stalked the pace in second flight along the rail, was steadied a bit off the leader approaching the bend, shifted outside that foe in upper stretch to challenge, drew on terms with the winner in late stages but was outfinished. TOUCHMEWITHMAGIC, reserved just off and outside the second flight early, made a brief, four wide bid midway through the turn but flattened out in the drive. JACK AND MAX, a bit fractious in the gate, vied between foes as part of the second flight, then gave way in upper stretch. POLISHED BRITELY was a bit outpaced early and never gained striking distance. HERE COMES HENRY tracked the pacesetter three wide in second flight and gave way after a half.
