GOOD LUCK SHAMROCK mid pack and inside, steadied into the turn for racing room, moved up and angled out to bid into the stretch, then closed well and drew off quickly under steady pressure. KHUKURI vied for the early lead inside, took command into the turn, then could not match the winners stride in the lane while clearly best of the rest. MELO set the early pace between rivals, could not go with KHUKURI into the turn, stayed on and held the show safe. CONSULATE improved his position, inside. NOT SO FAST FESTUS passed tiring rivals. TINQUILCO (CHI) was a brief factor, inside. CORNETTO stalked the early pace three wide, drifted out into the stretch and faded. JESTINTIME was a brief factor, outside. JAYEMBRO was outrun.
