Footnotes

PHONE JOAN broke readily, took up a stalking position racing just off the pacesetter to the backstretch, drew on terms with that foe on the far bend, bid for command nearing upper stretch, then turned back SMOLDERIN GEM to edge clear under brisk right handed pressure. The latter tracked just behind the leaders on the rail to the backstretch, switched out three wide to challenge nearing upper stretch, gained terms with the winner momentarily but proved only second best in the drive. DINNER AT LIDO'S was caught four wide racing into the first turn while gaining a position with the second flight, angled to the inside midway through the backstretch while making steady progress, then switched out four deep leaving the second bend and continued evenly for a share. JAMI PARI, allowed to settle in the opening half, swung out on the far turn and steadily improved position. NANI'S PRINCESS sprinted to the lead, dictated the pace along the inside to the far turn, then gave way once headed by the winner. DESERT STAR was never a factor. STRONGWILLED STUKA tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, but steadily faded from contention on the far turn. PANDORASCONNECTION shied a bit at the start and never menaced thereafter.
