Footnotes

WILLIE PREVAIL well placed and off the rail, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, drove clear the final furlong and held under moderate pressure. TAPILU well back and inside, moved up three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, closed well through the lane to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. BOURBON KING well back and inside, moved up through the second turn, altered out in the stretch for clear racing room and lacked the needed late kick. JIX mid pack and inside, moved up through the second turn, came through inside of rivals and flattened out. STALKING LION passed tiring rivals. RED SHOES pressed the pace inside and faded after three quarters. IN FOR A SONG ran evenly for three quarter and had no rally. BLADE SCUFFLER set a fast pace outside and stopped.
