RUSTIC ROAD set all the pace along the inside and held gamely to be clear under strong pressure. OUR FAMILY AFFAIR pressed the pace, raced three deep and was no match for the winner. GOOD GUY LARRY stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide in the lane and had no late winning bid. READY TO ROLL settled off the early pace, saved ground and had no late gain. ERV THE BANKER was slow early and never was a real threat. MONDOVI stalked the leaders and weakened. NOT SO FAST FESTUS raced four wide in the stretch and never was a factor. WILLOW PARISH stalked the pace and tired readily in the final stages.
