### Footnotes

QUITE ACCEPTABLE well back and inside, angled out to loop rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. WARREN'S JACK V. well placed and off the rail, moved up three wide through the second turn, gained a short lead into the stretch, then got clear the final furlong and was outfinished. ROGUE RIVER tracked the early pace on the rail, angled out into the stretch to bid, then had a mild late gain. OUACHITA CREEK stalked the early pace off the rail, moved up between rivals down the backstretch, gained a short lead, then weakened. STITCHNTWINE set the early pace inside and gradually faded. COTSWOLD HILLS improved position. HAITIAN moved up, inside. PLEASANT PROSPECT showed little. ENLISTEE stalked the early pace outside and was through after a half.
