APPEAL TO THE KING was away alertly, raced just off the inside through the turn into the stretch, dug in gamely under strong pressure and was in hand late. VANDERBILT BEACH was slow early, moved up six wide in the stretch and gained ground gamely in the latter stages. ROYAL TRAMP was slow early, raced four wide in the lane and had no final winning bid. ORANGE THUNDER stalked the pace, moved up three wide and had no late winning bid. PENNANT FEVER pressed the pace and gave way. GOTTTCHA SILVER failed to respond. HIGH MOMENTUM failed to sustain a bid.
