Footnotes

SEENEMONNA T. V., unhurried saving ground in the opening stages, switched out midway through the far turn while commencing her rally, took charge nearing upper stretch and widened her advantage under pressure. WHO'S THE FOX, bumped, then shuffled back at the start, tracked the leaders along the inside to the far turn while making some progress, switched off the inside nearing upper stretch and continued well to secure second. FINE APPROVAL broke in, bumped WHO'S THE FOX, was quickly collected to track the pace between foes, angled outside leaving the second bend and continued well in a belated effort. HUNCH NO TRUMP went quickly to the lead along the inside, set the pace racing to the far turn and emptied out. STREAKINJEB, allowed to settle in early stages, came around foes on the far turn and continued to improve position to the end. FIRST LIGHT FLIGHT tracked the leaders between foes to the far turn, then faded nearing the lane. T DIAMOND, reserved in early stages, angled out nearing the lane and passed some tiring foes. RICHLI PLEASANT, pulling hard early, came around foes on the first turn to gain terms with the pacesetter, forced the tempo racing to the far turn and dropped out in the drive. CARTER'S LADY, a bit slow into stride, never gained contention. MOON MYTH was forwardly placed between foes but was through after three furlongs. DUCKS AND PIZZA, caught wide racing to the backstretch, gave way abruptly. QUAKERSBLUELADY was caught in tight quarters when cut off by RICHLI PLEASANT racing through the first turn, gave way abruptly, was soon outdistanced and walked off the course under her own power.
