PIZZAZZ, bumped and shut off at the start, recovered quickly to make a steady advance along the inside, waited a bit for racing room nearing the quarter pole, slipped inside rivals in the stretch to forge clear in the lane under some pressure and was taken in hand nearing the wire. RED CLAY CYDDY, bumped at the break by SALTY MAUD, chased the pace leaders between rivals to the bend, lost position when outpaced on the turn, then gained second late when making a second effort between rivals. SHARP CORNER was taken in hand at the start to track the pace outside, angled four wide leaving the turn to challenge for command, but couldn't sustain her bid in the final quarter. MELODI'S SONG, allowed to settle while well outside rivals, angled out entering the stretch to make some late progress while never any menace to the leaders. SALTY MAUD bore out at the break bumping the winner and RED CLAY CYDDY, was righted and hustled to force the pace along the rail, then gave way when headed by the winner in upper stretch. PRETTY LILLY was briskly urged from the outset to set the pace, dueled for command to the quarter pole and gave way.
