PEPTALK was held up off the leaders while angling inwards racing to the first bend, continued unhurried for a half, shifted off the inside entering the far turn gathering momentum, split foes three wide leaving the midway point of the far turn to challenge, gained command in upper stretch and held ADVICE TO SINNERS safe under firm encouragement. The latter, reserved in the opening half, saved ground while steadily gaining contention on the far turn, closed the gap on the winner late but was always second best. SPOOKY MI tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight, made steady progress to challenge leaving the far turn but was no match for the top two. CRYPTIC AFFAIR, caught five wide in early stages, raced four wide on the far turn, and continued willingly in that path to the end. SASS tracked the leaders just off the inside in the opening half but came up empty racing through the far turn. YOUR IMAGINATION, caught six wide racing into the first turn, made some progress around foes to briefly challenge for command after a half, but quickly dropped out in the drive. CODE NAME LISTO, close up along the inside early, was eased off the pace after the opening quarter, made a second effort to force the pace racing into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. CAMEFEO sped to the lead racing just off the inside, was spent after a half and gave way abruptly.
