LITTLE WAGON four wide through the first turn, moved up to loop rivals three wide through the second turn, bid widest into the stretch, then made a steady gain and edged ahead late. HYPE appeared hard to rated back, moved up to contention through the second turn and bid three wide into the stretch, then split horses late and missed. ALERIC well placed and outside, moved up through the second turn to bid three wide into the lane, closed willingly and did not have enough late. RATE OF CHANGE set a moderate pace on a long lead, remained clear to the final yards and was outfinished. COWBOY CHARLIE had an inside trip and lacked the needed late response. SMUGGLER'S HOLD passed a tiring rival. HOLD THE CHARGE stalked the pace outside, faltered in the drive.
