Footnotes

LIMO moved up quickly to set the pace inside, gained a clear lead into the stretch, then increased his margin and held under steady pressure. POWER PAWS bobbled at the start, moved up through the turn, bid between rivals into the stretch, then angled out slightly and closed well to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. GOOD GUY LARRY mid pack and on the rail, gained a striking position through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then had no late kick. GHOST SKIER well placed and off the rail, faded in the drive and held a share. GHOST DANCE mid pack and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, came four wide to bid and had no stretch rally. DESERT PRIZE broke sharply and was sent to vie for the early lead outside, then was through after a half. DOWNTOWN DELIGHT was a brief factor, outside.
