STIG'S DEPUTY stalked the pace, raced four wide in the stretch and finished gamely to prevail under all out pressure. TAKE HEART settled off the early pace, moved up five wide into the lane and gained ground gamely in the final stages. WEKIVA WACHEE was slow early, saved ground and showed good late interest. BREEZY POINT stalked the pace, raced four wide into the upper stretch and finished willingly to the wire. HEIR TO DIXIE pressed the pace, led briefly and faded the final sixteenth of a mile. CARELESS HUNTER vied for the lead and gave way. HIDDEN BLESSING was off a step slow, took up sharply through the turn and had no response thereafter. COWBOY'S PRAYER failed to sustain a bid.
