Footnotes

LITTLE WILLARD went quickly to the front from the break, dictated the tempo just off the inside through the backstretch, went clear into the lane and gamely held the challenge of EBISU (GER) under steady pressure. The latter was reserved in early stages, came inwards while making some progress on the backstretch, split foes to challenge leaving the second bend, closed the gap in the drive but came up second best. GOLD STUDDER, allowed to settle in early stages, saved ground to the stretch and improved position in the final stages. IT'S TRULY OBVIOUS was taken in hand to track the leaders from the outside, gained a striking position on the second turn but lacked a solid closing response. DIPLOMAT'S REWARD raced within striking distance from the outset, stalked just off and outside the pacesetter to the far turn, couldn't close the gap on that foe into the lane and was eased approaching the wire. PEAK INTEREST tracked the pace four wide into the first turn, made a brief advance from that position on the backstretch but soon flattened out. TRIBAL AFFAIR stalked just off the pacesetter saving ground to the far turn, couldn't improve his position and dropped out in late stages. DONTHELUMBERTRADER, a bit reluctant to load, dropped out early.
