SHAKOPEE stumbled at the start, recovered quickly to secure a forward placing, stalked just off and outside the first flight four deep on the backstretch, advanced readily to press the pace in that path on the bend, took command in upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady handling. TWO BAYOU broke out, bumped PRINCESS B G at the start, was collected to track just off the first flight racing to the bend, bid three deep entering upper stretch but proved only second best in the drive. PRINCESS B G, bumped at the start, came around foes racing to the lane and improved her position belatedly. MISS BARBARA RAY was settled in hand racing off the inside to the turn and passed some tiring rivals in the drive. CUTTIN IN duelled for command between foes into the turn, then gave way in upper stretch. OFFSHORE NEWS vied inside rivals on the backstretch but dropped out entering upper stretch. MISS CATALINA was hustled to contend along the rail but was spent after the opening quarter.
