Footnotes

YAPPAH DO broke readily, attended the pace outside a rival racing to the bend, increased the tempo after a half and prevailed in the final stages under firm handling. NOT SO FAST FESTUS broke sharply, dueled for command along the inside, resisted the winner to late stages but came up second best. GLADDENS CHOICE, hesitated at the start, was rushed to contention while angling inside, couldn't gain terms with the top pair and continued evenly in late stages. I'M NO ALTER BOY tracked the leaders along the inside and made an effort to improve his position in late stages. PERFECT BULL, bumped by BIG WIN and forced into the path of BIG BURGER and HEADS UP PENNY at the start, made some progress to regain position in the lane while altering his course in the final furlong. BIG WIN ducked in at the start, bumping several foes, was righted to chase the leaders from the outside to the lane but faded in the drive. KILABUCK was outpaced early and never mounted a serious challenge. BIG BURGER, bumped at the start, lost position and never menaced thereafter. WOVOKA GHOST DANCE chased the leaders three wide to the bend and gave way after a half. HEADS UP PENNY, bumped at the start, was soon outdistanced and walked off under his own power.
