Footnotes

INNISBROOK tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail in the opening quarter, swung out midway through the bend while commencing a sustained response and reeled in WON WONG WING in the final stages under firm handling. The latter, prominent between foes from the outset, dueled for command into the turn, shook clear nearing midstretch and just failed to contain the winner. CITY BOY tracked the leaders on the outside as part of the second flight and continued evenly for a share. MY FRIEND FRANK broke sharply, forced the pace racing three deep to upper stretch and gave way. LEXCUS tracked the pace along the inside to the bend but never mounted a serious challenge. DR TY tracked the leaders between foes, bid briefly nearing the turn but lacked the necessary final response. SURE MONEY showed little. KID RIGO was hustled up the rail to dispute the pace, dueled for three furlongs and gave way. TALKNOEVIL was off awkwardly and soon dropped out.
