Footnotes

CITYPRO, close up between foes in the opening stages, was forced to check off the pacesetter approaching the bend, regained her stride on the bend, came around foes three deep to challenge nearing midstretch and prevailed in the final stages under firm handling. CONCERT TOUR broke sharply, then was hustled along to dictate the pace off the inside racing to upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner. FREAKIN' OUT chased the pacesetter outside foes into upper stretch but couldn't produce the needed final bid. MIZ DAYJUR, caught in tight quarters and held up off a drifting rival just after the start, recovered to make some mild progress racing into the stretch. REDICULOUSFOREVER ducked in after the start impeding a rival and never gained striking distance. TOWN SCANDAL chased the pacesetter along the inside and gave way after a half. WORK IN PROGRESS, a bit fractious in gate, never threatened.
