### Footnotes

KIMME A STAR chased the pacesetter from between foes through the backstretch, gradually closed the gap on that foe through the lane to gain a narrow advantage, then held safe the challenge of SWEET RUHL under steady handling. The latter tracked the pacesetter racing four wide in second flight to the bend, made her bid from that position entering upper stretch, closed well late in a belated effort and just missed. DIABLO'S ASSEMBLY was hustled clear of her rivals, dropped over a bit on the backstretch, dictated the pace to upper stretch but faltered in the drive. CLASSY CON was allowed to settle in the opening stages, then swung out nearing the lane but passed only tiring rivals. ART DECO LADY tracked the pace three wide as part of the second flight on the backstretch, then steadily faded from contention on the turn. MISS PROOF was never a serious factor. MOON SINGER stumbled at the start, was quickly righted to chase the pacesetter along the inside, then drifted in and out in mid stretch while emptying out. GENIUS BABY raced a bit erratically along the rail in the opening quarter, tracked the pace saving ground to the stretch, then altered course avoiding MOON SINGER nearing the sixteenth marker.
