FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. \$25 to nominate, \$100 to pass the entry box and \$100 additional to start. WEIGHTS: Three-year-olds, 116 lbs; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$15,000 at one mile or over in 2002 allowed 3 lbs; \$12,000 in 2002, 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2001-2002, 7 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (On the scale). Total earnings in 2001-2002 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee.

Footnotes

HAM AND EGGS angled inwards just after the start to secure position just off the inside in second flight, tracked the leaders three wide to the far turn, continued in that path while rallying to the front in the lane and just collared PICNIC SPREAD under pressure. The latter attended the pace inside a rival racing to the backstretch, was roused to wrest command from that foe leaving the far turn, went clear in upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner late. MOONLIT MADDIE was allowed to settle along the rail, saved ground throughout and continued to improve her position to the end. SARAH JADE angled inwards just after the start, made the pace in hand racing off the inside to the far turn but weakened once headed. LADY TAMWORTH tracked the pace outside foes to the backstretch, continued four wide to the far turn but offered no rally. BARE LEGS saved ground stalking the pace to the far turn but faded in the drive. WESTERN DELIGHT was settled off the leaders and never mounted a serious challenge. MADAM PERSUASIVE was angled to the rail in early stages, tracked the leaders to the far turn but came up empty when called upon to advance. RUFF ARRIVAL, reserved off the early pace, never menaced. CHERIS' TRUTH was urged to join the second flight racing into the first turn, tracked the pace three deep for a half and dropped out entering the lane.
