Footnotes

ONE MILE LIMIT, reserved in hand racing to the backstretch, steadily gained position while switching out leaving the far turn, found an opening five wide entering upper stretch, split foes rallying to the fore in mid stretch and drew clear under firm encouragement. NAPERVILLE worked her way to the inside racing to the backstretch, tracked just off the first flight to the far bend, split foes to challenge nearing mid stretch but was outkicked. TRICKY TAMI switched outside some rivals racing into the first turn, pressed the pace three wide into the far bend, gained a narrow advantage in upper stretch but couldn't last. POLAR BABY raced unhurried along the inside to the far turn, came out, split foes racing into the lane and continued with some mild progress. POTRITHREAT (ARG) went up from the break, dueled for command along the inside to the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. ADVANTAGE PLUS, allowed to settle off the leaders, raced six wide on the backstretch and never gained contention. HONEST ICE AGE was caught four wide on the first turn and never gained contention. OUR COLUMBINE tracked just off the first flight to the far turn, then gave way abruptly nearing the lane. SUMINISTER, forwardly paced from the outset, pressed the pace four wide into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. SMOKIN AFFAIR attended the pace outside a foe to the backstretch, dueled for command into the far turn and soon gave way. ANOTHER QUEST trailed.
