SOME SAY was hustled to the lead while outside rivals, went clear while angling inwards entering the turn, held sway under confident handling to upper stretch, then turned back LA CELESTE in the final stages under a few right handed taps to prove clearly best. The latter, never far back, tracked the pacesetter in the opening stages racing three wide between foes, advanced in that path on the bend to challenge outside the pacesetter entering upper stretch but proved no match in the final stages. POP THE LATCH, forwardly placed between foes from the break, exchanged bumps with RARE CRYSTAL after the opening furlong while chasing the pacesetter, continued willingly for a share but was no match for the top two. CATCH A STAR was settled while angling to the inside, saved ground to upper stretch but never gained contention. DAMARA tracked the pace off the inside to the bend and faded from contention early. RARE CRYSTAL chased the pacesetter along the rail from the outset, exchanged bumps with POP THE LATCH after the opening furlong and gave way nearing upper stretch.
