ASK EDDY stalked the pace, moved up four wide into lane and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. COWBOY LUKE pressed the pace, raced three deep and finished gamely to the wire. R SKYDIVER set all the pace along the inside and weakened. SWIFT PROGRESS raced in tight quarters along the inside soon after the start, moved up five wide in the lane and showed good late interest. MILES HEIR settled off the early pace, raced towards the inside and had no late winning bid. VICTORY CHECK saved ground and never menaced. VINI VIDI VINCI was slow early and never threatened. I'M THE GOLD tired readily and was eased up on in the stretch.
