VICTORY CHECK mid pack and inside, gained position through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. MR. RANCHO VISTA vied for the early lead outside, challenged for and gained a short lead into the stretch, then gained a clear lead late and was no match for the winner. THE QUINNSTER set the pace on the inside, could not go with MR RANCHO VISTA into the stretch, stayed on to hold the show safe and be clearly best of the rest. SHRYOCK well back and outside, moved up three wide through the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and got up for a share while no threat to the top three. DIXIE BUCK void of speed, passed tiring rivals. TAPINOT well placed and outside, gained a striking position through the second turn, came three wide to bid and faded in the drive. NOT SO TIMELESS showed little. CHOP SLEWY ran evenly. COTSWOLD HILLS well placed and on the rail, faded after a half.
