FIRST CAPTAIN well placed and three wide, angled in into the second turn to moved to a striking position, angled out and fanned five wide to bid into the stretch, then dueled with LITTLE WAGON through the lane and edged ahead in the final strides. LITTLE WAGON void of speed, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, dueled with the winner and missed. LUCKY MOON stalked the early pace outside, bid just outside that one into the stretch, then evened out the final furlong. CORPORATE CHAPEL well placed and inside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid and flattened out. FREEDOM FIRST allowed to settle, moved up three wide through the second turn, steadied off heels into the stretch, angled in and closed well, then weakened the final sixteenth. GRANDPA ROY well placed and between rivals, moved up quickly three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, then weakened in the drive. FREE SAILING set the early pace inside and faded after three quarters. MAGIC BULLET was no factor.
