Footnotes

MR. B L T rated close up, angled out through the second turn to bid just outside the pace setter, dueled with that one through the lane and drove clear late. RED SHOES set the early pace on the inside, gained a clear lead quickly, then dueled with the winner through the lane and was outfinished. CHIEF I THIRTYFIVE void of speed and off the rail, moved up through the second turn to bid three wide into the stretch, then closed well to get up for the show while no threat to the top two. ADRISA rated back and inside, moved up on the rail to gain a share. JIX never far back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, then ran evenly in the lane. TIGERSTARK chased the early pace from between rivals and faded steadily. STRIKE A NOTE stalked the early pace three wide and stopped.
