CAVIAR EMPTOR sped quickly to the lead while dropping over to the rail, dictated the pace to the far turn, turned back MEGANS MOLLY racing into upper stretch and held safe the late challenge of TRICKY TRUTH under firm handling. The latter was guided to the rail to stalk just off the pacesetter to the backstretch, tracked that foe to upper stretch, came out nearing the furlong grounds to close the gap but came up second best. DEVIOUS DAME, reserved saving ground as part of the second flight, came out a bit on the backstretch while tracking the leaders, saved ground on the second bend, then switched out in late stages to make a mild challenge. PERSUADE tracked the pacesetter between foes in second flight, angled out entering the backstretch, bid three deep for command leaving the far turn but finished evenly in late stages. MEGANS MOLLY angled inwards from the break, chased the pacesetter into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. LIFE JACKET, allowed to settle to the backstretch, saved ground to the far turn but offered no rally. SOPHIE was caught outside foes in second flight racing four deep to the backstretch and never gained contention. SINGING DIXIE dwelt, then hopped at the start, lost position and never regained contention.
