MISS OUTRAGEOUS sped quickly clear of the field along the inside, opened a commanding margin on the turn and held sway to the end while being kept to the task. MCKENNA BEACH was held up off the pace in the opening stages, switched outside foes while making steady progress racing into the lane but proved only second best. GHOSTLY GATE tracked the leaders off the inside, bid between foes into the lane and continued evenly in the drive. ASPEN GAL, allowed to settle in the opening quarter, came out a bit on the turn gaining some position but lacked the needed final bid. VALIDA angled inwards in the opening stages, chased the pacesetter into the turn, switched inwards impeding a rival near the seven sixteenths marker and gave way after a half. IDE BE PROUD, close up between foes in early stages, was checked off VALIDA nearing the turn, lost position and couldn't menace thereafter. PAULA O stumbled badly at the start and trailed.
