Footnotes

JACK AND MAX sped to the fore outside foes racing into the first turn, attended a rival's pace to the far turn, was roused clear in upper stretch and widened his advantage under pressure. MACK'S BLACKHAWK broke sharply, disputed the pace along the rail racing to the far turn but proved no match in the drive. BLACKHAWK'S GOLD broke awkwardly, angled out nearing the backstretch to gain terms with the second flight, lodged a three wide bid leaving the far turn but flattened out in the drive. RISDON was switched off the inside to track between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, advanced on the leaders in tandem with a rival on the far turn but couldn't produce the needed final bid. TUGFIRE angled inwards while gaining a contending position in the opening stages, tracked just off the first flight to the backstretch, then steadily faded after a half. JR HILLS drifted out on the first turn and never seriously menaced. DIXIE BUCK was never a factor.
