Footnotes

FUSE BUSTER was hustled up the inside to engage a rival for command racing through the first turn, dueled under pressure to upper stretch, drifted out bumping SECRET WORD leaving mid stretch but continued grudgingly to prevail on the wire. ONE HUNDRED WAYS tracked the leaders outside some foes as part of the second flight, angled outside the leaders entering upper stretch to challenge and closed well late. SECRET WORD angled inwards soon after the start, dueled for command outside FUSE BUSTER racing through the far turn, was bumped and forced out by that rival in late stages and was outfinished approaching the wire. SMOKIN AFFAIR tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside, angled outside entering the lane, challenged between foes through the final eighth but was outfinished. BACI DI DAMA broke a step slowly, was then cut off by a rival after the start, recovered to make a steady rally racing six wide into the lane and closed well belatedly. PLAY IT KERRY was guided to the rail entering the first turn, tracked the pace along the inside to the lane but lacked a closing bid. ROO'S MASTER PIECE was caught seven wide on the first turn and never gained contention. SHADES OF COLOUR was rated between foes just off the inside to the backstretch but gave way entering upper stretch. CALL ME ELIANE never seriously menaced. JOYFULL PROSPECT was caught wide throughout and offered no rally. JACQUES CORONET shifted inwards on BACI DI DAMA at the start and was

spent after a half. ZIPPITY ZAPPIN was through early. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AND DISQUALIFIED FUSE BUSTER, PLACING HIM THIRD FOR INTERFERENCE.
