Footnotes

CEDARWOOD sped to the lead while angling to the inside from the break, dueled for command with a rival from the backstretch into the far turn, shook clear in upper stretch and held J T KINGFISHER safe under steady pressure. The latter took up a tracking position between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, came through from between foes making a steady advance on the leaders entering the far turn, drew on terms with the winner late but proved only second best. I'M L W bumped by TAPESTRY IN MOTION at the start, was quickly collected to join the pace outside a rival, pressed that foe racing to the far turn but weakened in the drive. PUTYOURLEFTFOOTIN tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight to the far turn, then continued evenly racing into the lane. AFFIRMED ACTION tracked the pace four wide in second flight between foes to the backstretch, couldn't mount a closing response and was weaving in and out in late stages. ESKIMO KISS tracked the leaders as part of the second flight along the inside to the backstretch, dropped off those foes after a half, continued to save ground to upper stretch but lacked any further rally. TAPESTRY IN MOTION broke out, bumped a rival, was steadied off that foe at the start and never menaced thereafter. BAGHDAD BOB, allowed to settle outside foes, never seriously menaced. RIPPLEINBLUEWATER never a factor. PINE SIREN caught 5-wide first turn, brief bid far turn, faded in drive.
