GHAZI UP went readily to the fore along the inside, momentarily relinquished the lead to a rival after the opening quarter, asserted himself to dictate the pace on the backstretch to upper stretch, then gamely repelled a bid from SIR TRICKY in the final stages to prevail. The latter raced unhurried saving ground to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention along the inside nearing upper stretch, switched out to split foes in the lane, drew on terms with the winner late but couldn't best that rival. SIR RABBIT was a bit rank under rating in early stages, switched outside foes on the backstretch, then continued to make steady progress while being fanned five wide into upper stretch. MR PLAYWRIGHT was held up off the pace tracking between foes to the backstretch, briefly awaited an opening leaving the far turn, then made a belated effort to close the gap on the leaders four deep. ONOTHEREGOSTOKYO, pulling hard early, advanced on the first flight four wide nearing the far turn to briefly challenge for command, but failed to sustain his momentum through the final quarter. CANARD tracked just off the leaders to the backstretch, made a brief, three wide bid on the far turn but quickly emptied out. COME ON JOE was urged to join the pace outside a rival from the break, pressed that foe to the far turn, then gave way in the drive.
