PATCH OF BLUE well back, moved up through the second turn, came three wide to bid into the stretch, split foes in the lane and closed fast to get clear inside the final sixteenth. JIX well back, moved up on the two path through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch and closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. KING OF THE SKY set the early pace inside, then was rated back nicely inside, angled out into the stretch to bid three wide, drifted in slightly and evened out. GRANDPA GEORGE tracked the pace on the inside, angled out to move up three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, gained a short lead the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. RAJABLOU vied for the early lead outside, edged ahead down the backstretch, then weakened in the drive. FAR FLUNG mid pack and inside, pulled to contention into the second turn, steadied, then moved up, was blocked and steadied again and faded. HURRICANE HOUSTON hopped at the start, was no factor. EL WILDCAT hard to rate in the early going, looped three wide through the second turn and faded in the drive.
