Footnotes

MS MANANA stalked the early pace outside, moved up to challenge for and gain a short lead into the stretch, then lasted under brisk handling. NABISCO CAT tracked the early pace off the rail, moved up on the two path through the turn, angled in and came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then closed willingly through the lane and missed in the final strides. PRAIRIE VISION well back, looped rivals three wide through the turn to gain position, came four wide to bid into the stretch and evened out. IS THIS A SECRET well placed and three wide, gained position through the turn, bid on the same path into the stretch and flattened out. SUNDAY PRINCESS sent from the gate to set the early pace off the rail and faded at the head of the lane. HALO'S TIDE improved her position. NEXT TOP MODEL stalked the early pace inside and stopped. SAM LORD'S BELLE rushed up inside, steadied into the turn and faded.
