**Footnotes**

TEJANO'S CONEJA attended the leaders' pace racing just off and outside those rivals in the opening stages, advanced readily to challenge three deep midway through the bend, collared MS FANCY PANTS in upper stretch, then bested that rival through the lane while drifting inwards and bumping her repeatedly under steady right handed pressure. MS FANCY PANTS advanced to the front from between rivals, dueled for command into the turn, edged clear nearing the lane, resisted the winner grudgingly when challenged and exchanged bumps with that rival while under left handed encouragement, but came up second best. LILIAS LADY tracked the leaders racing outside rivals, passed tiring foes into the lane, but was never a real menace. ADAMS GLORY, outpaced early despite some pressure, angled inwards on the bend, but never gained contention. SHUR WILL was hustled along the rail, dueled for command into the turn and gave way after a half. CROWNING GLORY retreated steadily.
